

The Nina T-shirt

Sewing a T-shirt
Cutting a personalised neckline
Working with jersey fabric
Double needle hem

Timing: 4h-6h of sewing
Material: 1m of jersey fabric (preferably cotton)
1 spool of 100m thread
optional shoulder pads

The Aretha Long Dress



Techniques you will learn:
Sew jersey
Make a slit
Sew a collar in jersey
Create a clean armhole
Sew a sleeve

Timing: 6-9 hours of sewing Material: 1m50 of rather thick jersey fabric 10 cm of twill tape (back collar finish) 1 spool of 100m thread







Techniques you will learn:
Sewing tweed
making a "cigarette"
sewing a sleeve in 2 pieces
Chanel finishes: fringed braid,
chain...

Timing: 12h to 21h sewing Material: 1.50 m of tweed (preferably wool) 1m50 of lining

8 gold buttons (depending on look selection)
Scraps of padding fabric (sleeve cap
reinforcing)

1 spool of 200m thread

The shopping bag (Christiane)



Techniques you will learn:
Assemble a lined bag
use padding and rigid lining
Create a quilted handle

Timing: 12 hours of sewing
Material: 50cm of thick upholstery fabric
50cm thick lining
50cm of rigid interfacing
1m of thick rope (worn on the shoulder)
6m bias
1m50 of decorative twill ribbon
2 spools of 100m thread

The Jumpsuit



Techniques you will learn:
Adjusting a jumpsuit
Visible zipper
Sewing pockets
Sewing pants
Mounting a collar
Sliding an elastic band

Timing: 21 hours of sewing
Material: 1m50 of fabric (sleeveless + shorts)
2m (short + shorts) 2m50 (short + pants) 3m50
(long + pants) 4m (long + pants + pockets)
Contrasting fabric option: 1m of fabric
1m of elastic (2.5cm wide)
1 50cm zipper

1 50cm zipper 2 spools of 100m thread

The Short Jacket



Techniques you will learn:
Putting together a jacket
Putting together a collar
Buttoning paste Sewing pockets
Sewing a button

Timing: 12h to 18h of sewing Material: 2m of fabric (2m50/3m for balloon sleeves) 50cm of interfacing

5 to 7 buttons (25 mm) 1 spool of 100m thread

The lined mini skirt



Techniques you will learn:
Sew a lined garment
Sew a dart
Sew a hem
Add a lining to a garment
Install a zipper

Timing: 12 hours of sewing Material: 70cm to 1m of fabric 70cm to 1m of radius lining 1m of twill ribbon 2.5cm wide 1 18cm zipper 1 spool of 100m thread

The man's shirt



Techniques you will learn:
Sewing a multi-piece garment
Button placket
Sewing on buttons
Cuff Collar stand and shirt collar

Timing: 12 hours of sewing Material: 2m 50cm of iron-on interfacing 1 spool of 100m thread 8 buttons or snaps

The Coat



Techniques you will learn:
Sewing a multi-piece garment
Lining Collar
Patch pockets
Interfacing

Timing: 21 hours of sewing Material: 3.50m of fabric (knee length) 2 m of lining

2 m of interfacing (adhesive or not)

2 shoulder pads for special raglan coat


2 buttons (2cm diameter)

2 spools of thread (100m)

Haute Couture

Your experience: several finished garments, you want to move up a gear and learn the techniques of the great haute couture atelier (so lots of things by hand and work at home between classes)

The Gabrielle jacket



Making a toile
Slipper & slip stitch
Creating a trim
Sewing a sleeve in 2 pieces
Pattern matching
Assembling invisible lining
Quilting

Points techniques:

Applying chain stitch
Stay tape for reinforcement

Timing: + 21 hours of sewing (+ homework)
Material: 1m50 of tweed (preferably wool)
1m50 of lining

6 special jacket clips

1 spool of 200m thread

scrap

1 spool of tacking thread (contrasting color to the fabric)

10m of fine twill ribbon 1cm wide 3 to 6 m of trim braid (depending on the look) 1m of fine interfacing - wadding scraps 1m of metal chain, silk organza (or polyester)
